

STATEMENT OF REMOVAL

The following article, which was published in Proceedings of the Thirteenth International AAAI Conference on Web and Social Media (ICWSM 2019), has been removed from publication by agreement between the authors and the journal.

THIS PAPER HAS BEEN REMOVED DUE IN PART TO THE FACT THAT THE COLLECTION AND THE RELEASE OF THE DATASET THAT IS THE CENTRAL FOCUS OF THE PAPER VIOLATED TERMS OF SERVICE AND DATA PRIVACY LAWS AND REGULATIONS, AND FOR THESE REASONS THE UNDERLYING DATA SET WAS COMPLETELY REMOVED FROM THE PUBLIC REPOSITORY THAT WAS HOSTING IT AND NO LONGER EXISTS.

IN ADDITION, THE PAPER ITSELF VIOLATES THIRD PARTIES' LEGAL PRIVACY RIGHTS, AS INDICATED BY THE OPINION OF THE ETHICS COMMITTEE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MILAN. THE COMMITTEE FOUND A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 5 OF THE 2011 CODE OF ETHICS, AND A VIOLATION OF ARTICLES 5 AND 89 OF THE EUROPEAN UNION'S GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR), SINCE FIGURE 2 OF THE PAPER REPORTS A MASTODON USER'S USERNAME AND PROFILE IDENTIFIER, ENABLING THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE DATA SUBJECT.

FINALLY, THE COMMITTEE ALSO RECOGNIZED A FURTHER ISSUE RELATED TO THE RELEASE OF THE DATASET. THE DATASET CONTAINED CONTENTS OWNED BY THE USERS OF THE PLATFORM BUT IT WAS RELEASED UNDER THE CREATIVE COMMONS CC0 LICENSE, WHICH REQUIRES TO HAVE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS TO APPLY IT TO ANOTHER PERSON'S CONTENT.
